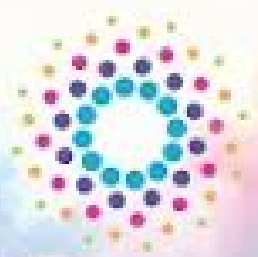
## SPOTLIGHT

This month's spotlight is on the fantastic [Hub at Foulston Park](#). The Hub at Foulston Park is a community-focused hot spot for locals in Devonport and Plymouth. Foulston Park is a large complex in phase 2 of its construction, soon to be home to Plymouth Argyle Football Club Women's and Academy teams, multi-use games area (MUGA), new indoor 3G football pitch, and additional outdoor football pitches. The athletics track and field and outdoor 7-a-side pitch is already available to hire.

The Hub is the newest member of the Plymouth Wellbeing Hub Network offering a range of health and wellbeing opportunities, including a state-of-the-art gym, physical activity programmes, mental health support, youth and veterans' programmes, community cafe, and a soft play! Since their initial public consultation in 2022, Argyle Community Trust have been dedicated to growing alongside the community wants and needs, welcoming feedback on how to support the community The Hub resides in.

The Complex Emotions Hub is a five year UKRI-funded research programme, aiming to advance understanding and care for people living with and experiencing complex emotions often associated with 'Borderline Personality Disorder' (BPD), EUPD, and Complex PTSD. I am proud to say I am on the Lived Experience Advisory Panel for this research project, and am a huge advocate for the systemic change that this project centres around.
