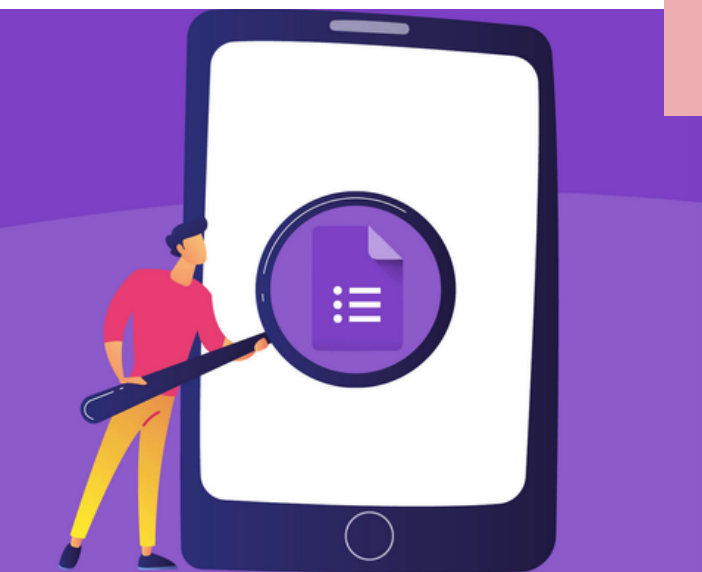
THE FUTURE OF D&C
